PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Rottweilers, except Champions of Record, that are 6 months of age and under 24 months of age on the date of the show. All dogs shown in the Sweepstakes MUST also be entered in one of the regular classes. Indicate your sweepstakes class with the age on the Entry Form.

Dogs, Puppy - 6 months/under 9 Months	Bitches, Puppy - 6 months/under 9 months
Dogs, Puppy - 9 months/ under 12 Months	Bitches, Puppy - 9 months/under 12 months
Dogs - 12 months/under 15 months	Bitches - 12 months/under 15 months
Dogs - 15 months/under 18 months	Bitches - 15 months/under 18 months
Dogs - 18 months/under 21 months	Bitches - 18 months/under 21 months
Dogs - 21 months/under 24 months	Bitches - 21 months/under 24 months

Winners of the 6 months through 15 months will compete for Best Sweepstakes-Junior. Winners of the 15 months through under 24 months' classes will compete for Best Sweepstakes-Senior. Best Sweepstakes-Junior and Best Sweepstakes-Senior will compete for Grand Sweepstakes Winner.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

PRIZE MONEY

After deducting 35% for Host Club expenses, the remaining Sweepstakes Entry Fees shall be divided as follows:

Classes with 4 or more entries: 1st 40%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%, 4th 10%
Classes with 3 entries: 1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20%
Classes with 2 entries: 1st 60%, 2nd 40%

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

The Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Rottweilers that are 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Dogs shown in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in one of the regular classes. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are eligible to enter Veterans Sweepstakes. Indicate your sweepstakes class with the age on the Entry Form.

Winners of the 6 months through 15 months will compete for Best Sweepstakes-Junior. Winners of the 15 months through under 24 months' classes will compete for Best Sweepstakes-Senior. Best Sweepstakes-Junior and Best Sweepstakes-Senior will compete for Grand Sweepstakes Winner.

SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

PRIZE MONEY

After deducting 35% for Host Club expenses, the remaining Sweepstakes Entry Fees shall be divided as follows:

NON - REGULAR CLASSES - involving single entries: classes are divided by sex:

Veterans (7 years and older) - May be spayed or neutered
BEST OF BREED COMPETITION
BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR
BEST PUPPY FROM THE REGULAR CLASSES

AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may award (with no consideration of sex) an Award of Merit to up to 10% of the dogs shown in Best of Breed class: Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the Veterans Class winners shall be considered for these awards. Rosettes will be awarded to the Rottweilers which best exemplify the breed's characteristics.

NON - REGULAR CLASSES - involving multiple dog entries

- ◆ **Stud Dog Class:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. The award will be based on the merits of the Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog MUST appear in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog Class shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. This being the First Entry Fee plus the Additional Entry Fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. A First Entry Fee for the Stud Dog Class if not entered in a regular class or Best of Breed Competition. The Additional Entry Fee is for the unit.
- ◆ **Brood Bitch Class:** Same as Stud Dog Class. Substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get".
- ◆ **Brace Class:** Two dogs of the same breed with identical ownership regardless of sex. Dogs may be entered for Brace competition ONLY for First Entry Fee per dog. If the Brace Class is an additional entry, then the Additional Entry Fee is for the unit.
In making entries for "Brace Class Only", full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for additional classes.
If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated, Brace#1, Brace#2, etc.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged First Place in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.
- ◆ **Parade of Champions and Title Holders:** Dogs entered in this class may or may not be entered in a regular class, however, must be holders of an American or Foreign Champion of Record Title, Obedience Title, Agility Title, Tracking Title, Herding Title or Foreign working or conformation title. The class will not be judged. Please send a brief printed or typewritten resume of the dog along with your entry (will be condensed, as necessary). Must be pre-entered.
Each entrant will receive a Rosette with the dog's name and titles imprinted on it.

Single copies of the latest editions of rulebooks applying to Dog Shows, Discipline, Registration, and Obedience may be obtained WITHOUT CHARGE from any Superintendent at any show where they are superintendent or from THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB, 5800 CENTERVIEW DR #200, RALEIGH, NC 27606.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows", and the "Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline" and, if this entry is for an obedience trial, the "Obedience Regulations," have been made available to me (us), and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) waive any and all claims, causes of action, I (we) might otherwise have against the AKC and any AKC approved judge, judging at the show, under AKC Rules, Regulations and Guidelines. I (we) agree that the club holding this show or obedience trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies. I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the show or obedience trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim: and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of this dog by disappearance, theft, death of otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage, or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Dog Show Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 15, Section 3.)
